



WHAT TO EXPECT FROM THE NEUROMARK[®] EXPERIENCE



1 | PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE

Plan for about a 1-hour appointment. Make sure to discuss with your healthcare provider any changes to your medical history and/or medications you are currently taking.



2 | DURING YOUR PROCEDURE

The NEUROMARK procedure is typically performed in your doctor's office using only local anesthetic. The NEUROMARK device and an endoscope are placed in the back of your nose, where the target nerves are located. The therapy itself takes only a few minutes. The treatment should not be painful, and you should experience little to no discomfort, though you may feel pressure.



3 | AFTER YOUR PROCEDURE

Typically, recovery involves no downtime, allowing you to get back to your regular day.* You may experience a temporary increase in congestion. Most patients begin to see improvement about 4 weeks after treatment.¹



4 | FOLLOW-UP

Your healthcare provider will speak to you regarding any necessary follow up appointments. Always reach out to your healthcare provider with any questions or concerns regarding this procedure.

NEUROMARK is a gentle procedure to treat the source of your chronic rhinitis. The treatment is safe, clinically proven, and minimally invasive.^{1,2}
